

Appointment Checklist

- ✓ If you are a new patient, complete the Patient & Health History Form and the HIPAA Authorization Form. You are encouraged to fill-out the forms online, or download the forms, complete them, and bring them to your appointment. If you plan to fill the forms out in our office, please come in 15 minutes early to handle the paperwork. (New Patients Only)
- ✓ Your eye examination appointment with the doctor is scheduled for 45 minutes. Please allow 5 to 10 minutes for check out.
- ✓ Your eyes may be dilated as a part of your eye examination. If dilation is necessary, expect for your vision to be blurry up close and light sensitive for up to 2 hours.

Contact Lenses

- ✓ Come in wearing your contact lenses for at least 1 hour.
- ✓ If you are a new patient, please bring the contact lens packaging from your contacts or a copy of your last contact lens prescription. (New Patients Only)
- ✓ Keep in mind, we have in stock Acuvue 1-Day Moist, Acuvue 1-Day TruEye and Acuvue Oasys contact lenses. Most other contact lenses arrive the afternoon of the next business day if ordered by 3:00pm.
- ✓ We ship annual supplies of contact lenses direct to you free of charge.

Glasses

- ✓ Bring all prescription glasses that you currently use including readers and sunglasses.
- ✓ If you are interested in looking for glasses, we recommend that you come in ½ to 1 hour before your appointment to browse our selection.
